The Arc advocates for and with individuals who experience disabilities. Below is the latest.

SB 1606 - Health Care

The Arc, along with many community and state-wide partners, were recently busy advocating for the passage of SB 1606. Imagine your loved one with disabilities being hospitalized and unable to have a support person with them to help make critical health care decisions? Senate Bill 1606 ensures people with disabilities have access to healthcare by: Mandating hospitals allow support people to patients as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act, consistent with the order recently released by US Health and Human Services and current Oregon Health Authority guidelines. Clarifying that Crisis Care Guidance may not include provisions that consider the presence of a disability as a determinant factor in the decision of who gets care and who does not. Ensuring that people can have support from people they choose if they are discussing lifesaving or end of life care. *On Friday evening, June 26th, the bill passed unanimously, topping off a great week of hard work for our community! Thank you to all who wrote letters!*




